



The Village of McCook retained zpd+a as the design architect for the 27,000 sq. ft. expansion of the McCook Athletic and Exposition Center located in McCook, Illinois known as the Max. The Max facility is a 123,000 sq. ft. sports facility which contains four soccer fields, basketball and volley ball courts and indoor batting cages. It is also the home of numerous programs for children. zpd+a was requested by the Village to program and design a two story addition to the east end of the existing structure that would provide additional men's and women's bathrooms to supplement the existing facilities bathrooms when concerts and major sporting events were to be held in the existing facility. Men's and women's locker room and family locker rooms were also provided. The balance of the first level contains offices, security station and a storage/ service area. The second floor contains a shelled out space for a future restaurant and a full size basketball court that also provides a banquet hall for 250 people. The project will go out to bid to contractors in January of 2011 and will be completed and occupied by October 2011. The Village of McCook is currently in negotiations with a restaurant chain for the second floor restaurant space.
